This form is to be completed *in capital letters*, signed, and handed to an instructor before training for the first time. Payment of the insurance is mandatory. **No valid insurance means no training!** Membership is open to all adults – 18 years of age or

more. However, it is subject to an instructor reviewing your health questionnaire (see below) and the non-refundable payment of the insurance fee. After a couple of classes, if you decide that Aikido is for you, you will need to pay a yearly club membership fee and get a dogi (Japanese martial art suit). If you are unemployed or a university students, class fees are lower – ask for details. You can pay monthly at a much reduced cost per class.
